## Regulation

### of the match between the national teams of schoolchildren of Russia and India

#### 1. Goals and objectives

- popularization of chess.
- strengthening international relations between chess players and national chess federations.
- determining the winners of the competition.

#### 2. Organizers of the competition

The general management of the competition is carried out by the All-Russian Public Organization "Russian Chess Federation" (hereinafter referred to as the RCF).

The direct conduct of the competition rests with the panel of arbiters.

The main arbiter is an international arbitrator A.S. Vashurin (Russia).

#### 3. Security

Security during the competition is entrusted to the chief arbiter and tournament director and is organized in accordance with the requirements of the current Regulations on inter-regional, All-Russian and international sports activities and sports events on chess and RF legislation.

#### 4. Dates and venue.

The match between the national teams of schoolchildren of Russia and India is held from 1 (day of arrival) to 11 June (day of departure) of 2019 as part of the additional program of the open All-Russian chess competitions "White Castle".

The venue of the competition is Krasnodar Territory, Sochi, Dagomys, FGAU OK Dagomys, UDP of the Russian Federation (Leningradskaya St., 7.).

The match between the national teams of schoolchildren of Russia and India on classical chess is held according to the current FIDE rules separately between boys and girls.

Swiss system in 8 rounds with a fixed draw.

Time control: 90 minutes for the whole game for each participant with an increment of 30 seconds for each move made, starting from the first move.

The match between the national teams of blitz teams in Russia and India is held according to the current FIDE rules (article B.3). Boys and girls play together.

Swiss system in 8 rounds with a fixed pairings

Time control: 3 minutes for the game with the increment of 2 seconds to each move, starting from the first move.

Requirements for match participants:

- it is forbidden to enter into negotiations about a draw before the 40th move inclusive;
- It is recommended to refrain from wearing sports uniforms and shoes in the playing hall.

## **6. Definition of winners.**

Team locations are determined by the total number of points scored by all team players in 2 disciplines: classic chess and blitz.

Classic chess - 2 points are awarded to a player for a victory, 1 point for a draw, 0 points for a loss.

Blitz - 0.5 points are awarded for a player's victory, 0.25 points for a draw, and 0 points for a loss.

In the case of equality of points scored by all players of the team in 2 disciplines, the places are determined by the greater number of points scored by all players of the team in classic chess.

## **7. Award**

The winning team is awarded a cup, diplomas. Team players are awarded with medals, diplomas and special prizes of the RCF.

## **8. Financing**

The RCF bears the costs of organizing and holding a competition in accordance with the regulatory documents governing the financial support of sports events for 2019 and according to an approved cost estimate for holding this competition.
