



EUROPEAN YOUTH CUP 2012

KUTAISI (GEORGIA)

6 – 13 July, 2012

GENERAL REGULATIONS

1. Invitation

The Government of Georgia, Georgian chess federation and Imeretian chess federation under the patronage of European Chess Union President Mr. Silvio Danailov, have the honor to invite all ECU member federations to participate at the European Youth Cup, which will take place in Kutaisi, Georgia between July the 6th (arrival) and July the 13th (departure).

2. Venue & Schedule

The championship will be held in Kutaisi new "Sport Arena" (900 sq.m - built in 2009)

3. Basic Information about the Tournament

- The championship will be held in 3 categories for girls and boys (up to 8, 10, 12 years). The players should fulfill the conditions that they didn't reach the age of 8, 10, 12 years by January 1st of 2012.

- The championship will be based on 7 round Swiss system in accordance with the ECU Tournament Rules and Fide Rules of Chess. The time control will be 90 minutes for the whole game with an increment of 30 seconds per move, starting from move one.

4. Registration

- The deadline for the registration is June 5th, 2012.
- In order to provide appropriate tournament conditions, the Federations must complete carefully the official registration form and send it back to the contact person before the registration deadline June 5th, 2012.
- After June 5th, 2012 the organizer have the right not to register player and hotel prices can be increased.
- The registration fee for players is 50 Euro. The registration fee can be transferred or paid after arrival in Kutaisi.

5. Lodging and meals

All players and guests are invited to stay in:

- Private sector (about 500 – 700 meters from playing hall) – prices of triple, double or single accommodation (with all necessary facilities) are from 5 to 10 Euro each person each day.
- Hotel "I meri" *** - FB for per person per day costs:

- Reservations and payments for hotels must be made before June 5th, 2012.

7. Tie – Break

In case of equal points the order of players will be determined by the following tie-break procedures:

1. Median Buchholz 1, the highest number wins
2. Buchholz, the highest number wins
3. Progressive score
4. The greater number of victories

8. Travel and Visas

- The organizer will provide transport services of all participants from Batumi International Airport (130 km) or Tbilisi international airports (220 km) to Kutaisi hotel on July 6th as well as the departure transfer on July 13th.
- Travel price from Batumi airport (2 ways) to Kutaisi hotel is a 40 Euro
- Travel price from Tbilisi airport to Kutaisi hotel is for each person 60 Euro.
- If any delegation arrives one or two days before the competition the same service will be provided.
- The EU, Turkey, Israel, former SU including Russia and almost all European countries citizens do not need Georgian visas. They will get free of charge stamp in Batumi or Tbilisi airport. The citizens of FYR of Macedonia will get Georgian visa easily in Batumi or Tbilisi Airport. The cost of visa is about 25 Euro.
